The Mennello Museum of American Art is currently featuring hidden art treasures from the Cornell Fine Arts Museum of great American art that covers a large time span with a highlight of American women artists and racial inclusion that is rarely seen.

One exhibit is a piece by artist, Kara Walker, who uses her signature silhouette over a Harper's Weekly cover illustration. Her perspective seeks to bring attention to the lack of minority representation in historical news of the time and the stereotypically stylized manner that was used to display African-Americans. CSA students used her perspective to create their own silhouettes and art work.

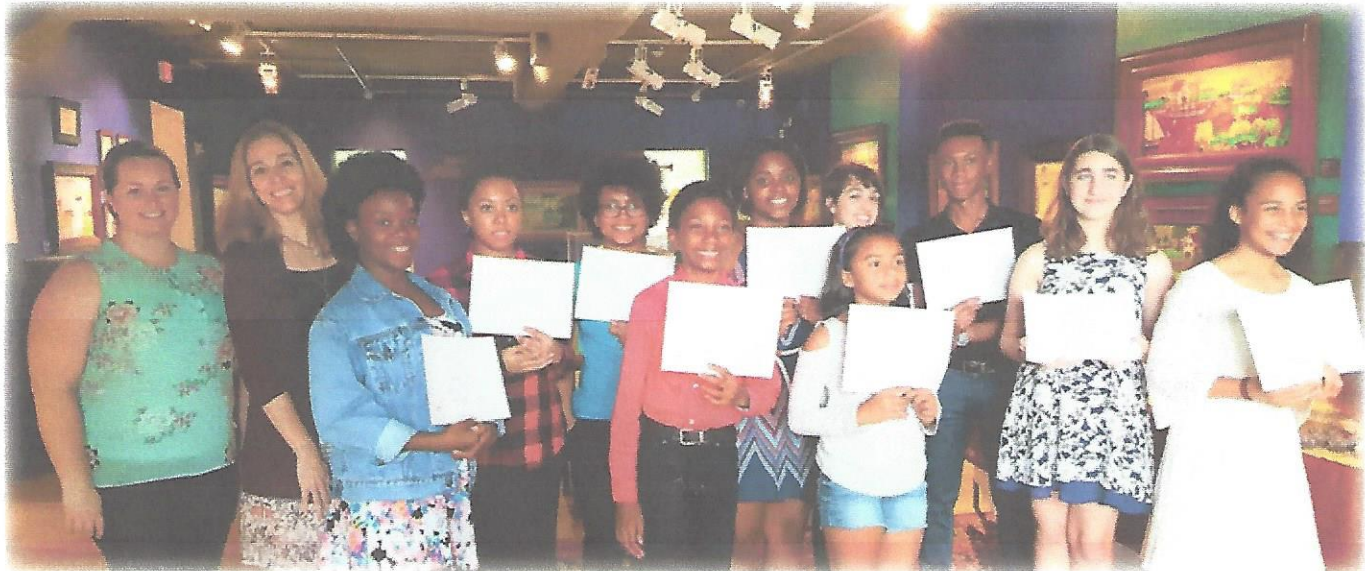
